Aries Solar Fire Festival~Oratorio: Notes & Credits

This musical offering is a fusion of vision, dedicated labor, technology and resource. Since 1998 Michael Robbins and I have collaborated toward the creation of an auditory experience which would provide listeners and ceremonial participants with a realistic choir and symphonic orchestra performance of music created for Solar Fire Festivals.

This project represents the culmination of our first decade of technological advances, midi and audio innovation, and the creation of extensive in-house production protocols and editing techniques which allow for increased realism. Our five-voice ensemble becomes a *virtual choir* through a number of engineering steps which are designed to preserve diction in order that the lyrics be understandable to the listener while sounding like a full choir.

Our first orchestrations utilized stock MIDI sounds from synthesizers, whereas our most recent productions feature nearly 500-gb of instrumental samples from the Vienna Instruments Library. These remarkable sounds allow us to express orchestral textures which range from the delicate solo of a violin to the rich sonority of a full brass section. Finally we are able to present realistic orchestrations that bring this music to life.
